Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday


# D READING O'CLOCK TIMES ON A CLOCK

## Method How to Read 'O'clock' Times

A clock has two main hands: the long hand (the minute hand) and the short hand (the hour hand). To read an "o'clock" time, you need to look at both hands.

- 1. Look at the long hand first. When the long hand points straight up to the number 12, it means there are 0 minutes. It is an "o'clock" time.
- 2. Then, look at the short hand. The number the short hand points to tells you the hour.

Ex: Look at this clock. It is early in the morning. What time does the clock show?



#### Answer:

- The long hand is pointing to the 12, so it is an "o'clock" time (0 minutes).
- The short hand is pointing to the 3.
- $\bullet$  Therefore, the time is 3 o'clock. We write this as  $3{:}00.$

Since it is morning, the time is 3:00 in the morning.
