Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday

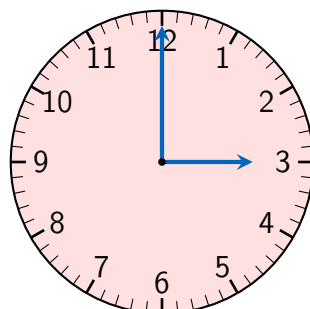
D READING O'CLOCK TIMES ON A CLOCK

Method How to Read 'O'clock' Times

A clock has two main hands: the long hand (the minute hand) and the short hand (the hour hand). To read an "o'clock" time, you need to look at both hands.

1. **Look at the long hand first.** When the long hand points straight up to the number **12**, it means there are **0 minutes**. It is an "o'clock" time.
2. **Then, look at the short hand.** The number the short hand points to tells you the hour.

Ex: Look at this clock. It is early in the morning. What time does the clock show?



Answer:

- The long hand is pointing to the **12**, so it is an “o’clock” time (0 minutes).
- The short hand is pointing to the **3**.
- Therefore, the time is **3 o’clock**. We write this as **3:00**.

Since it is morning, the time is 3:00 in the morning.
